Application

Due to its strong polar character Efka[®] MI 6779 increases the electric conductivity or, in other words, decreases the electric resistance of a liquid or solid paint film. The product being highly surface active encourages dispersion of the paint into fine droplets whilst being electrostatically sprayed.

Although Efka[®] MI 6779 may be added to the mill base prior to pigment dispersion it is predominately used as a post-additive. This allows the conductivity to be specifically adjusted to suit the requirements of the spraying equipment used. However, in case of a post-addition it is essential that it should be properly stirred into the batch to ensure adequate dispersion.

recommended concentrations

The dosage depends on the desired degree of conductivity and the polarity of the solvents but is usually between 0.2 and 1 %.
