Biosilico CS.PC.5299 is a **colloidal dispersion of bio-based oleophobic silica**, synthesized from Rice Husk and used as a Multifunctional Additive for multiple applications based on **Aqueous systems**.

Product Benefits

- Repels oils, hydrocarbon fluids, water, lubricating oils, petroleum products etc.
- Improvement in hydrophobic and oleophobic properties for aqueous coatings and treatments.
- Easy to clean/self cleaning effect
- Improvement in substrate wetting, water resistance, bluish resistance, Anti-blocking properties and weather resistance
- Recommended for use in aqueous topcoats such as 2 component polyurethane, alkyd/melamine, polyester/melamine, acrylate/melamine and acrylate/epoxy combinations.
- Due to high surface activity, colloidal silica accumulates on the surface of the coating, and because of -OH reactivity (Primary & secondary), it can be integrated into the polymer network by reacting with suitable binders. Hence, effects of which are maintained for a long period of time.
- Advanced material with high purity from bio-based organic source.
- **Recommended dosage:** 4-8% (as supplied on total formulation weight.)
- **Incorporation:** Oleophobic colloidal silica should be added towards the end of the production process and incorporated in the coating at a sufficient shear rate.

Storage and Handling
